Dear Mr. Battle:

The following is required by the Texas Department of Transportation before authorization can be made for the City of College Station to construct the landscape monument proposed on highway right-of-way at the southwest corner of FM 60 and the SH6 West Frontage Road:

- ❖ The enclosed resolution executed by the City of College Station and returned to the Department.
- ❖ A statement that:
 - a) the City of College Station shall indemnify and save harmless the state, its officers, employees, agents, and contractors from claims and liabilities due to the placement of the landscape monuments, or
 - b) the City of College Station acknowledges its responsibilities for the acts and omissions of its officers, employees, agents, and contractors, to the extent permitted by applicable law, if the city is unable to provide indemnification.
- ❖ Evidence that the City or its contractor has obtained adequate insurance naming the department as a coinsured in an amount and form on TxDOT Form 1560, Certificate of Insurance, (see enclosed Form 1560) for the payment on any damages which may occur during the time of construction of the landscape monument.
- ❖ Should the work require utility installation crossings, a separate utility accommodation permit shall be executed prior to any work being performed.
- ❖ A complete set of plans for our review prior to the City receiving bids if the work is performed by a contractor or prior to the work should the City perform the work with its forces.

A RESOLUTION FROM THE CITY OF COLEGE STATION, TEXAS TO THE STATE OF TEXAS REQUESTING THAT THE CITY BE ALLOWED TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN CERTAIN LANDSCAPING MONUMENTS AND OTHER APPROVED INSTALLATIONS TO BE SITUATED WITHIN THE RIGHT OF WAY ON CERTAIN NON-CONTROLLED ACCESS HIGHWAYS AT THE ENTRANCE TO THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION, SAID INSTALLATIONS AND OTHER LANDSCAPING TO BE PLACED AND MAINTAINED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE DIRECTIONS FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THAT SAID INSTALLATIONS SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE AND UNDER THE MAINTENANCE AND CONTROL OF THE CITY UNTIL SUCH TIME AS WRITTEN NOTICE IS RECEIVED BY EITHER PARTY REQUIRING REMOVAL OF THE INSTALLATIONS FROM THE RIGHT OF WAY; AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXECUTION OF SAID RESOLUTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION:


That the resolution dated this date from the City of College Station to the State of Texas for the construction, maintenance, control and supervision of said landscaping monuments and other installations on portions of those certain designated State Highways in the City of College Station be, and the same is hereby approved; and that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute said resolution on behalf of the City of College Station and to transmit the same to the State of Texas for appropriate action.

Reinstall exist. sprinkler controller


Install separate breakers for lights & controllers

Install second meter pedestal, breaker panel, & exist. sprinkler controller, at Post Oak Mall location only


Relocate 2 Toro 570 - 6" pop-ups inside of raised planters

Remove exist. vac. breaker, replace with 1" Dbl. check valve + plastic box


Existing concrete curbs
