

**AMENDMENT TO AND RENEWAL OF
THE SERVICE CONTRACT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION
AND THE SANITATION SPECIALIST**

WHEREAS, on July 2, 1999, the City of College Station, Texas, a Texas home-rule municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as "City"), entered into a contract with The Sanitation Specialist (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), for the cleanup of Northgate Promenade;

WHEREAS, the City desires to renew the contract with Contractor for such services and the existing contract allows the contract to be renewed by written agreement approved and executed by the parties;

WHEREAS, the City desires to expand the scope of services of the contract and in consideration will compensate Contractor an additional Two hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$200.00) per month for a total of Two Thousand Four Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$2,400.00) above the previous agreed upon sum; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Contractor agree to revise the contract to add a provision that would allow for the addition of the services and allow for the additional compensation to be paid to Contractor;

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the recitations above and the covenants expressed hereinbelow, the parties agree to amend paragraph 2 and the Scope of Services of the original contract (revised text indicated in **bold** format), as follows:

- "2. In consideration of the Contractor's final completion of all work in conformity with this Contract, as amended, the City shall pay the Contractor the sum of **Twenty Thousand Four Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$20,400.00)**. Within **seven (7)** calendar days of completion of the work, the Contractor shall submit his application for payment to the City, and the City shall pay Contractor for the work performed no later than **thirty (30)** calendar days from the date of the City's receipt and the City's approval of the work and the application for payment. This Agreement has been made under and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas. The parties agree that performance and all matters related thereto shall be in Brazos County, Texas."


SCOPE OF SERVICES
