A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS, IN SUPPORT OF VOICE OVER INTERNET PROTOCOL (IP) RESEARCH BY TEXAS A&M UNIVERSITY (TAMU).

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of College Station, Texas, understands both the current difficulties in locating certain persons dialing 911 for emergencies and the need to develop methods of locating such persons, and wishes to be proactive in the development of solutions to these difficulties through emerging technologies; and

WHEREAS, TAMU plans to apply for a grant to develop a research program designed to establish a Voice over IP (VoIP) enabled Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) that will be beneficial in addressing the above need; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of College Station, Texas, desires to support said project proposed by TAMU; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS:

PART 1: That the City Council hereby acknowledges the potential value to the City of research designed to develop methods of locating persons dialing 911 for emergencies.

PART 2: That the City Council hereby approves and supports Texas A&M University's plans to apply for a grant to develop a research program to develop methods of locating persons dialing 911 through VoIP systems for emergencies.

PART 3: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.


