A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS, APPROVING THE NAMING OF THE LIBRARY IN COLLEGE STATION, THE LARRY J. RINGER LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, during the many years of public service, Dr. Larry Ringer's leadership, vision and hard work contributed to making the City of College Station an outstanding community for our citizens, students and visitors; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Ringer provided vision and leadership in gaining support and voter approval for the creation of a new public library in College Station which opened in 1998 and he continues to serve as Chairman of the Library Committee; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Ringer served with honor and distinction as a member of the College Station City Council from 1976 through 1983; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Ringer served as Mayor of College Station from 1986 through 1995 and provided strong and effective leadership for a rapidly growing university community; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Ringer was instrumental in the establishment of the first cooperative joint use agreement between the City of College Station and the College Station Independent School District in 1987 that is still the foundation for many collaborative programs that continue to this day; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of College Station, Texas:

PART 1: That the City Council hereby finds that Dr. Larry J. Ringer should be appropriately honored.

PART 2: That the City Council hereby approves the naming of the library in College Station, the Larry J. Ringer Library.

PART 3: That the City Council directs city staff to place the signage at the library as follows:

LARRY J. RINGER LIBRARY

PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.


