

Cities in the Big 12 Conference

1. **Waco, TX (Baylor University):** They have no pertinent ordinance in this area and they have no similar business or bar area.
2. **Lubbock, TX (Texas Tech University):** Lubbock is a dry town and has no package stores in the city that alcohol can be purchased. Because of these regulations they have no similar issues or ordinances to address such.
3. **Norman, OK (University of Oklahoma):** They have a city ordinance that prevents open containers with the intent to consume in public areas.
4. **Stillwater, OK (Oklahoma State University):** They also have a city ordinance that prevents open containers with the intent to consume in public areas.
5. **Boulder, CO (Colorado University):** No open containers are allowed in public places.
6. **Manhattan, KS (Kansas State University):** They have an open container ordinance for public places and they also have a game day ordinance that requires alcohol on game day be in a plastic or paper cup. This applies to the bars in the area where they often have people out on balconies.
7. **Lawrence, KS (Kansas University):** Consuming in public is illegal. No open container in public areas.
8. **Lincoln, NE (University of Nebraska):** No consumption in public which is especially enforced on game days.
9. **Columbia, MO (University of Missouri):** City ordinance prevents open container anywhere in the city.
10. **Ames, IA (Iowa State University):** State law prohibits consumption in a public place.
11. **Austin, TX (University of Texas):** City ordinance prevents open container as spelled out in predefined business district.
