

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE ASSIGNING THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION'S FRANCHISE AGREEMENT WITH MINI-DUMPSTER TO CCAA, LLC, DBA BCS STOP 'N GO POTTIES FOR THE USE OF ROLL-OFF CONTAINERS LOADED BY WINCH TRUCK IN HAULING RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION DEBRIS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of College Station granted a franchise to MINI-DUMPSTER a company whose sole proprietor was Samuel Smith with effective dates of February 1, 2003 through January 31, 2005.

WHEREAS, Samuel Smith sold MINI-DUMPSTER to Ruben Escalante who now desires the assignment of Franchise No. 2607 to CCAA, LLC doing business as BCS STOP 'N GO POTTIES contingent on final closing on the sale of MINI-DUMPSTER; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS:

- PART 1: That Ruben Escalante as sole proprietor of MINI-DUMPSTER is hereby conditionally substituted and approved as successor in interest to and having all rights, obligations and privileges as set out in Franchise No. 2607 contingent upon receipt of an acceptance letter and an acceptable Certificate of Insurance from Mr. Escalante.
- PART 2: That the assignment to Ruben Escalante is conditioned upon Mr. Escalante assuming all rights, obligations and privileges as set out in Franchise Ordinance No. 2607.
- PART 3: That CCAA, LLC doing business as BCS STOP 'N GO POTTIES, is hereby conditionally substituted and approved as successor in interest to and having all rights, obligations and privileges as set out in Franchise No. 2607 contingent upon the successful purchase of MINI-DUMPSTER from Mr. Escalante and upon the receipt of an acceptance letter and an acceptable Certificate of Insurance from CCAA, LLC doing business as BCS STOP 'N GO POTTIES.
- PART 4: That the assignment to CCAA, LLC doing business as BCS STOP 'N GO POTTIES is conditioned upon CCAA, LLC doing business as BCS STOP 'N GO POTTIES assuming all rights, obligations and privileges as set out in Franchise Ordinance No. 2607.
- PART 5: That this ordinance shall become effective ten (10) days after the date of passage by the City Council, as provided by Section 35 of the Charter of the City of College Station.


