

F. POSSESSION OF GLASS, METAL OR PLASTIC CONTAINERS IN AREAS WHERE PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person in the City of College Station, Texas, on any public right-of-way or street, or within or on any City of College Station, Texas owned vehicular parking area, park, esplanade, sidewalk or pedestrian-way, located in the Northgate Area as defined below, to possess any glass, metal or plastic beverage container.

1. **NORTHGATE AREA:** That area bounded by University Drive to the south, South College Avenue to the east, the City of Bryan to be the north, and Wellborn Road to the west, specifically including the three said boundary streets and their intersections with each other.
2. **EXEMPTIONS:** Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, nothing in this section shall prohibit the possession of the following described containers within the Northgate Area:
 - (a) containers, such as baby bottles and baby food jars, containing products specifically intended for consumption by babies;
 - (b) containers, the presence of which are not openly discernable to the ordinary observation of a reasonable person, located within motor vehicles;
 - (c) wax or plastic coated paper or cardboard containers;
 - (d) containers possessed by Permittees or Licensees, as defined in the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code, such possession allowed by right or privilege granted the respective Permittee or Licensee by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission; or
 - (e) sealed containers being then directly transported for delivery to the holder of a license or permit issued by the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission, or a sales tax permit issued by the comptroller of public accounts of the State of Texas.
