Re: Northgate Options

The Legal department has discussed and identified the following options to resolve alcohol issues at the promenade and the Central Business District for you and the Council to consider.

Northgate Options:

1. Pass an ordinance that prohibits the possession of an open container and the public consumption of alcoholic beverages in the City's central business district.
2. Pass an ordinance that prohibits the possession of an open container and the public consumption of alcoholic beverages in the City's central business district and allow exceptions for game days or special events.

3. Allow a mixed beverage license holder to obtain a catering permit for the promenade / Allow a wine and beer license holder to obtain a temporary permit for the promenade which authorizes the license holder to sell alcoholic beverages on the promenade.
4. Post signs prohibiting kegs and coolers of alcoholic beverages on the promenade only and enforce it pursuant to state law as a criminal trespass offense.
5. Pass an ordinance banning metal and plastic containers on the promenade.
6. Pass an ordinance banning metal containers on the promenade.
7. Pass an ordinance banning metal containers over 12oz. on the promenade.
8. Choose not to pass any ordinance at this time and work on increasing law enforcement on the promenade.
