A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS, APPROVING GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY FOR FUNDING FROM THE STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security receives and administers grant funds under the SAFER Program, in accordance with the Final Rule published in the Federal Register on March 25, 2005, for the purpose of making funds available for local projects that qualify under the list of eligible categories; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of College Station desires to apply for an Assistance to Firefighters Act SAFER Grant for assistance in paying a portion of the salaries and benefits for ten additional firefighter positions; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE STATION, TEXAS:

- PART 1: That the City Council hereby approves the grant application for \$1,000,000.00.
- PART 2: That the City Council hereby agrees to provide over a five (5) year performance period the local match contribution of \$1,294,002.00.
- PART 3: That the City Council hereby authorizes and designates the Fire Chief for the City of College Station Fire Department, or his designee, to sign the grant application for this grant on behalf of the City of College Station.
- PART 4: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.


