Re: Proposed Street Name Change

Dear Haley Drive Resident:

In an effort to maximize efficiency for emergency responders including fire, police, and medical services, the City of College Station strives to maintain street names that are clearly distinguishable from others within our local 9-1-1 service area. It has been brought to our attention that there are two streets sharing the Haley name in College Station. Currently we show six addresses on Haley Drive in the Foxfire subdivision and 45 addresses on Haley Place in the Southwood Valley subdivision. Based on this information, we are recommending to the College Station City Council that the Haley Drive street name be changed.

We have researched possible street name alternatives and in an attempt to maintain the existing street naming theme of Foxfire, we recommend that Haley Drive be renamed to Hemingway Drive. We will be bringing this item to City Council on October 6th, 2005. If City Council approves this name change, it will be effective on October 16th, 2005. The United States Postal Service will still recognize your Haley Drive address for one year if a change of address form is submitted.
